The Aurora Fox Arts Center Announces Auditions for Chinglish

July 27, 2016 – Aurora, Colo. – The Aurora Fox Arts Center announces auditions for “Chinglish,” Sunday, August 7, 1:00-5:00 p.m., 9900 E. Colfax, Aurora. Actors of all physical abilities are welcome to audition for all roles. To audition, prepare a one-minute monologue and a quick story about a time when you were immersed in an unfamiliar culture. If you have language skills, please be prepared to speak a few phrases in Mandarin. Total audition time will not exceed five minutes. Callbacks are by invitation only. Written by Tony Award winner David Henry Hwang, “Chinglish” is a hilarious comedy about the challenges of doing business in a country where the language and underlying cultural assumptions can be worlds apart from those of the West. The play tells the adventures of Daniel, a businessman from the Midwest, who hopes to establish his family's sign-making business in China. Through a comic exchange, he learns what is lost and found in translation. “Chinglish” runs March 24-April 9, 2017 at The Aurora Fox.
